

SELECTED MEDICINE-RELATED TITLES FROM MICROFORM ACADEMIC PUBLISHERS

Dissertations read to the Edinburgh Royal Medical Society, 1751-1970

Notes: Founded in 1737, this is the oldest student society of its kind in the United Kingdom, whose members were duty-bound to deliver a dissertation for examination by their peers. This collection comprises over 200 volumes of hand-written dissertations, providing a unique insight into the development in medical teaching and thought during the last 250 years. In subject, the dissertations range from framboesia to fear, from meningitis to mongolism and many represent the earliest original work of famous men of medicine. United States Sanitary Commission: documents and bulletins, 1861-1865

Notes: At beginning of the American Civil War, the non-fighting public expressed a desire to contribute to the cause. Through the co-ordinated efforts of a small group of medics and churchmen, a Commission of Inquiry and Advice was established. This collection includes their inquiry into the condition and needs of troops, from nursing to diet and cleanliness, together with the Commission's twice weekly bulletins, which began in 1863, reaching a circulation of 15,000 by the end of the war.

The Johnston papers : the collected autobiographical, literary, medical, scientific and travel notebooks and diaries of Dr John Johnston

Notes: Born in Annan in Dumfriesshire, Scotland, Dr John Johnston (1852-1927) studied medicine in Edinburgh before setting up in general practice in Bolton, Lancashire, in 1876. This collection covers his varied intellectual, social, cultural, political and professional interests. Of particular significance are Johnston's notes on the poetry of Walt Whitman (1819-1892), as well as on his activities as a member of the Independent Labour Party, which it appears he joined the same year of its founding in 1893. Johnston's profound social concerns are also reflected in his medical writings, which include not only his thoughts on the doctor-patient relationship, but also provide a testament to the challenges Johnston faced as a doctor caring for WWI victims. The military hospital near Bolton, where Johnston worked during the First World War, was one of the few places in Northwest England where the wounded from the Front were sent.
